<u>A MEMBERS VOICE—Step 10—Phil H</u>

The Big Book states "Step 10 suggests we continue to take personal inventory and continue to set right any mistakes as we go along.....Continue to watch for selfishness, dishonesty, resentment and fear. When these crop up, we ask God at once to remove them. We discuss them with someone immediately and make amends quickly. The 12 & 12 differentiates among three kinds of inventories:

- 1) Spot Check—taken anytime we find ourselves getting tangled up;
- 2) Days end—"when we review the happenings of the hours just past";
- 3) Annual or semi-annual inventory when "we make a careful review of our progress since the last time."

A good example of a daily inventory is on p. 86 of the Big Book in the first paragraph, "When we retire at night," - By practicing Step 10 we are able to put our "AA way of living to practical use" and thus make our days "better and happier" and more productive.
